New Zealand actively recruits international teachers — especially in STEM, Special Education, and Te Reo Maori subjects. This kit walks you through the exact steps to get registered with the Teaching Council, land a position, and make a successful move to Aotearoa.

SECTION 1 | Requirements Checklist

New Zealand has a straightforward registration process compared to most countries. The Teaching Council of Aotearoa New Zealand (TCNZ) is the single authority — there is no state-by-state variation.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Bachelor's degree in Education or a subject area**
Minimum 3 years; 4-year degree preferred
- Teaching qualification from a recognized institution**
Must be comparable to NZ standards
- Evidence of teaching experience (at least 2 years)**
School employment letters or references
- Good character declaration**
Statutory declaration required by TCNZ
- Police clearance certificate from all countries lived in (5+ years)**
Must be recent (within 6 months)

ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

- IELTS Academic: Overall 7.5 (no band below 7.0)**
Required for non-native English speakers
- TOEFL iBT: Overall 96 (Writing 24, Speaking 23, Reading 24, Listening 24)**
Alternative to IELTS
- OET (Occupational English Test): Minimum B in all bands**
Less common but accepted
- Native English speaker exemption applies**
UK, USA, Canada, Australia, Ireland, South Africa

NZQA QUALIFICATION ASSESSMENT

- Apply for International Qualification Assessment (IQA) via NZQA**
nzqa.govt.nz — fee applies; no pre-approved list
- Request "Course-by-Course" assessment comparable to NZ ITE qualification**
Provide verified qualification documents for fastest processing
- Certified copies of all degree certificates and academic transcripts**
University must verify directly; translations required if not in English

VISA & WORK RIGHTS

- Accredited Employer Work Visa (AEWV)**
Employer-sponsored; most common visa for teachers with a job offer

- Straight to Residence Visa**
Primary/secondary teachers with job offer from NZ accredited employer
- Work to Residence Visa**
ECE teachers; full-time role of at least 12 months with accredited employer
- Working Holiday Visa (ages 18-30, or 18-35 for select nationalities)**
Work and travel in NZ for up to 12 months

PRO TIP

An Overseas Relocation Grant of up to NZD\$10,000 is available for qualifying teachers relo

SECTION 2 | Teaching Council NZ Registration

Registration with the Teaching Council of Aotearoa New Zealand (TCNZ) is required before you can teach in any NZ school. The process is online and manageable. Budget 8-12 weeks for processing.

PROVISIONAL vs FULL REGISTRATION

Type	Who Gets It	Teaching Rights	Next Step
Provisional Registration	New teachers or those completing a year with	Can teach with a mentor; 2-year limit	Complete provisioning program
Full Registration	Experienced teachers with NZ-qualified	Teach independently in any NZ school	Apply for Practising Certificate annually

PRO TIP

Apply for Full Registration even if you think you might only qualify for Provisional — TCN

SECTION 3 | Regions Hiring International Teachers

New Zealand faces a significant teacher shortage. According to the NZ Ministry of Education (updated May 2026), high-demand areas include secondary school STEM subjects (sciences, technology, engineering and mathematics), remote and rural regions, teachers of te reo Maori, and relief teachers. Every region is hiring, but areas below have the highest active recruitment.

SECTION 4 | NZ-Format CV Template

In New Zealand, a resume is called a CV (Curriculum Vitae). NZ CVs are typically 2-3 pages, include a photo (optional but common), and use a conversational, achievement-focused tone. Do NOT include age, marital status, or religion.

NZ cover letters are warm and direct. Address the school specifically, mention NZ registration status early, and close with confidence.

Term	Meaning
TCNZ	Teaching Council of Aotearoa New Zealand — the registration authority for all NZ teachers
AEWV	Accredited Employer Work Visa — the most common visa for international teachers with a job offer
SMC	Skilled Migrant Category — points-based permanent residency pathway
NZC	New Zealand Curriculum — the national curriculum framework for Years 1-13
Year levels	NZ uses Years 1-13 (not grades). Year 1 = approx. US Kindergarten
Whanau	Maori word for family/community; used widely in NZ schools
Kura	Maori-medium school (Te Reo instruction); separate registration pathway
MOE	Ministry of Education — the NZ government department overseeing schools
NCEA	National Certificate of Educational Achievement — NZ secondary qualification (Years 11-13)
